ABOUT THE WSCRC

Founded in 1979, the Washington State China Relations Council is the nation’s leading statewide organization dedicated to strengthening commercial, economic, and cultural relations with China. Through public programs, trade missions, investment delegations, and executive briefings for government and business leaders, the Council plays a central role in advancing trade and investment activities between China and Washington State. As an expert voice in the state that exports more goods to China than any other, the WSCRC also plays an active role in the national discussion on the future of the US-China relationship. With approximately 130 current and alumni members – global companies and individual leaders from the aerospace, banking, business, environment, government, innovation, industry, technology, philanthropic and academic sectors – the Council facilitates dialogue and constructive engagement between American and Chinese businesses and government leaders on key policy issues including investment, trade, environment and diplomacy. MISSION AND IMPACT AREAS (Reference pp. 2-13 below)

The WSCRC serves as the primary gateway for economic and cultural relations between China and Washington State, serving as an effective liaison and advocate for the public sector, private companies and individuals in both countries for advancement of mutual economic development and overall bilateral relations.

Strategy and Policy. The Council convenes, educates and advocates through public and custom engagements to advance Washington state-China relations, and the broader US-China relationship.

Innovation and Investment. The Council creates opportunities for bilateral Washington state-China investment flows, serving as the most effective partner for Washington companies and economic development agencies.

Culture and Community. The Council fosters robust relations with China relations through cultural, educational, and social impact exchange programs.

With approximately 130 current and alumni members, the Council’s membership comprises diverse sectors – aerospace, architecture, construction, education, government, logistics, legal, non-profits, real estate, technology, and universities. Following President Xi Jinping's 2015 visit to Seattle, in which WSCRC was an organizing leader, WSCRC



played a key role in organizing one of Seattle's largest ever business delegations to Shenzhen and Hong Kong, followed by a delegation to Hangzhou which was organized exclusively by WSCRC. This delegation resulted in the signing or announcement of nine major agreements and investments.

- Announcement by China Vanke, the largest residential builder in China, to invest for the first time in Seattle, partnering with developer Laconia and Seattle's Realogics Sotheby's International Realty to invest \$200 million into a residential tower
- Agreement signed between WSCRC and the Shenzhen Foundation for International Exchange and Cooperation to enhance strategic relationships and promote non-governmental cooperation between Shenzhen and Seattle, focused on cross-border enterprise and entrepreneur exchange, joint cultural and environmental programs
- Agreement signed between the City of Seattle and the City of Shenzhen to support "Collaboration and exchanges among relevant entities in medical research, medical education, and the biotech and health industry in Seattle and Shenzhen."
- Agreement signed by Washington State University and BGI to cooperate on efforts to establish and conduct programs and activities of basic and applied research, technology and information transfer and economic development
- MOU signed by Snohomish County and the Economic, Trade and Information Commission of Shenzhen Municipality to develop a long-term promotion of bilateral trade and investment between the two regions
- Agreement signed by Hangzhou Mayor Zhang Hongming and Seattle Mayor Ed Murray to promote cooperation in trade and economy, e-commerce, information technology, life sciences, education and people-to-people exchanges
- Two agreements signed by WSCRC signed agreements with Hangzhou business organizations to begin exchanging visits and cooperating to promote the growth of business ties in e-commerce, investment, education and tourism
